

PRIVACY POLICY

Protecting your privacy is important to us. This Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy”) describes how United for Oklahoma collects, uses and protects the personal information you provide us when you access and our use our channels, websites or applications or otherwise interact with us. By using UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM or other United for Oklahoma channels, websites, digital services, or Applications (collectively, the “Services”) that link to or refer to this Privacy Policy, you consent to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Information Collection

When you browse UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM, you do so anonymously. Personal information – including but not limited to your email address – is not collected unless you provide it to us when you subscribe to our newsletter or otherwise provide it to us through our Services. Your IP address (the Internet address of your computer) is logged and may be used to note channels of our network you're visiting most, providing us the information you're most interested in. UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM does not link your IP address to anything personally identifiable. However it is possible that your computer's IP address can be linked to your personally identifiable information through your Internet Service Provider.

If you send an email to us through the links provided on our website or to any email addresses that may be posted on the website, you may disclose your email address, name, and any other identifying information you send in your correspondence. We will not sell, trade or share any personal identifiable information that we receive through the contact links on UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM contact page or via email except (1) as is explicitly noted in the contact data; (2) as required by applicable law; (3) if we transfer UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM or our website to another entity; or (4) with your specific consent. Your email address, including any personal identifiable information that you may provide in your communications with us, will generally be shared within the Chickasaw Nation for information purposes only and with our agents and service providers as needed to provide and improve our services and offerings.

Use of “Cookies”

UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM utilizes a standard technology called a "cookie" to collect information about how the online property is used. A cookie is a small string of text that a website can send to your browser. Websites use cookies to enhance users' visits. You can set your browser to reject cookies or to notify you when a website tries to put a cookie on your computer. However, rejecting cookies may affect your ability to use all the features of our website.

Advertisement Tracking

UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM uses pixels, or transparent GIF files, to help manage online advertising. GIF files from our "Analytics Partners," (such as Google Analytics, DoubleClick, or Facebook), provide a unique cookie on your Web browser, which in turn enables us to learn which advertisements bring users to our channel. The cookie was placed by us, or by another advertiser who works with our Analytics Partners. With both cookies and Spotlight technology, the information that we collect and share is anonymous and not personally identifiable. It does not contain your name, address, telephone number, email address or other personal information. In addition to your IP address, the Applications may also automatically collect information specific to the type of device you use, the unique ID of your device, the type of operating system that runs your device, the type of internet browsers your device uses and information about the way you use the Applications.

The terms stated in this Privacy Policy regarding the treatment of data collected as a result of the UNITEDFOROKLAHOMA.COM website and channels also govern the data collected through downloading and use of the Applications. Accordingly, such data will not be sold, traded or shared with any third party except as noted above or as required by law.
